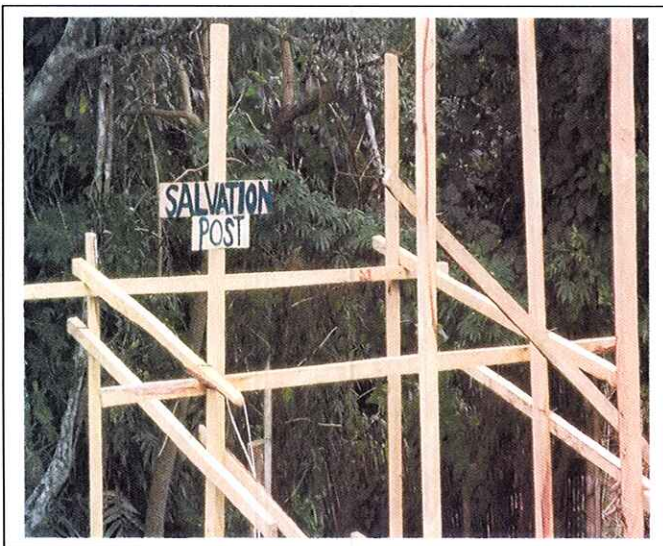
We praise the Lord, and thank many of you for your response in financial help for victims of the "Sendong" storm and floods. By His grace, and your generosity 10 pastors, their families and members were substantially assisted. Their smiles and tears, as we listened to the various stories of that night of tragedy, along with the stories of miraculous survival was a blessing to personally witness.



Our ground-breaking day for **Mt Calvary Baptist Church** was January 26 and our **construction began** immediately. We had approximately \$5,100 to start of the approximately \$465,000 needed to totally finish. **"Striving together for the faith of the gospel"** is our theme! God has provided within our church membership, an architect, two engineers and a faithful businessman on our building committee. Just this week several construction workers have come to know the Lord!

The week following, Dan began a new Bible study, several adult men came to know Christ as their Savior and the following week their wives requested to meet simultaneously with Edna. They too trusted Christ and were in our services that Sunday. They are also excited about the building program and already lent us a mechanical cement mixer to use for mixing cement for the church building. This is a great blessing in savings for rental of needed equipment.

Dan sent out one of our men to our previous church area and we harvested around 200 bamboos to also use in the construction. The Lord led us to plant bamboo many years ago. Another man was sent to our camp where we harvested pine trees so that MtCBC has very little expense in the wood needed for scaffolding and other support. Praise God for HIS leading in years prior for our present needs. These naturally grown materials are helping to stretch our limited funds.



We are naming the posts and/or pillars of our church based on the pillars of our faith from the Word of God. In this way we are teaching our people and the construction workers that this is a spiritual undertaking and a public testimony of the eternal truths of Scripture.

Our son Joseph arrives the end of this month and also a short term missionary, Miss Amanda McClure. Do pray for journeying mercies for them. Also, on **March 13, Dan will be traveling to the USA with Joseph** to re-claim his Immigrant status and Lord willing, American citizenship. While Dan visits for a few months in the states, **Edna will travel there as well on April 10** in order to attend the **May 4th College graduation of their daughter Anna** at Bob Jones University. Edna will return a few weeks later to the Philippines to oversee the ministries in Dan's absence.
