Dear Bro. Mckey and Friends,

We wanted to write and let you know that we remember you in prayer often here in our home. We trust that you had a good Christmas season and that things are going well for you as we start into 2012. This could be the year that the Lord will return. Certainly the "signs of the times" make one listen for the shout.

Chris and I are doing well. Back in November, Chris was having some chest pains and the doctors had her do a nuclear stress test and angiogram. They thought there might be some blockage in an artery so the doctor did a heart catheterization. After the procedure was completed, the cardiologist said there was no blockage. He said her heart looked good and concluded that the pains were probably caused by all the scar tissue from the serious car wreck we were involved in back in 1974.

We stayed put this year and didn't do any traveling over the holidays for a change. We were able to spend some time with our son, Jason and his family over the holidays. The weather was pretty mild here in the Ozarks which was welcomed by everyone.

On the ministry side, the end of the year inventory in the campus book store went very well and we were able to get it done ahead of schedule which was a huge relief. We started off the new year with a rush of book orders and printing to get all the course materials ready for the beginning of classes which resumed on January 19th. There are thirty-three new students enrolled for the spring semester here at the Missionary Training Center which brings our total enrollment to 109 missionary candidates. When you pray for more laborers for the harvest fields, please remember these folks; that they will be thoroughly equipped for ministry and that nothing would sidetrack them from the goal of getting out to the fields.



Recently, we were encouraged to hear that our graduates are having a fruitful ministry among the Siar people of Papua New Guinea and that many have put their faith in the Lord for salvation at the conclusion of months of teaching the Word and presenting the Gospel in their language.
