Higinio is from Guatemala, and Yasmin is from Honduras. Higinio's mother, Angelica, went back to Guatemala last year. We had been praying with her that he would be saved. After she returned back home, Higinio's brother was killed in an accident. Higinio and Yasmin started coming to church along with his sister, Luci, and her husband. Luci recently had a beautiful baby boy.

Marcela and Victor have had problems from a car accident where another Hispanic ran a stop sign and hit their car. He refuses to pay for the damages, which are over \$3,000. The young man who hit her is a citizen and has a driver's license. The car was covered on the parent's policy, but their son was driving. The insurance company refuses to pay because they say he is not listed on the policy. I have gone to court with them three times, and each time the judge tells them they need another type of proof. This family told Marcela and me outside the courtroom that they would never pay for the damages. They have gotten up in court and lied saying their son had taken the car without their knowledge. They also said he doesn't live with them. These are both lies. Marcela has brought everything that she was told to bring to court, but to no avail. The Judge said that Marcela doesn't have sufficient proof that they are lying. It seems that our justice system has some major problems.

We were in two mission's conferences the last couple of months. We were at Victory Baptist Church, our home church, here in Tennessee. It was an honor to be at this conference. We've been members of Victory since 1984. Our friends at Victory have a great love for missions and missionaries. We were also honored to be with the folk at Morningside Baptist Church in Greenville, South Carolina. It was a blessing to see old friends at Morningside whom we haven't seen in years. We saw some of the folk that visited us in Mante, Mexico. It was an honor to teach Sunday school and to preach in the Hispanic church. Pastor Miller is doing a great job leading the church into a deeper love for missions and missionaries. I would like to extend special thanks for the support, gifts, and offerings given to us. They truly were and are a blessing.

Thank all of you for your support. We have lost some support, but praise the Lord; He is still able to provide in these hard times. Everyone is suffering, and we are sure that you too are rejoicing that He is able to supply your needs also.
