Lauderdale has begun a new mission work in Plantation and is prospering. They are growing and looking for a permanent location to build or buy. Help us pray about this need also.

The church here is doing well with a few new families coming. God has given us a great church to work with, we just did our yearly financial report and almost 40% of our income has gone into mission out reaches. I know that our people have a desire to see souls saved and churches established. I am thankful to each of you for your prayers and support through the years we have been on the field doing what God has called us to do.
